To Whom It May Concern:

This is to confirm that I have known Kimi Zabihyan since around 1990 when we both worked at The London Observer. I was the newspaper's Defence Correspondent and she had just started The Observer's film company.

I recall chatting with her in the newspaper canteen about my experiences during the Falklands War when I was imprisoned in Argentina with two other British journalists and held for more than three months on charges of espionage. Kimi quickly picked up on the fact that I was curious to return to the prison in Tierra del Fuego to discover the attitude of the Argentine authorities and former inmates now that the passions had died down.

As a result, she began lobbying her contacts in the British television industry, and as a result arranged a deal with BBC2 for an entire series on individual memories of the Falklands War, which was broadcast over the weeks coinciding with the tenth anniversary of the Argentine invasion. I travelled with Kimi to southern Argentina, where, after making fairly cautious enquiries we discovered we would be welcomed back with a film crew. The ensuing documentary was shown as one of the BBC2 series, along with another documentary produced by Kimi based on an Argentine defence analyst.

I have no hesitation in saying that had it not been for Kimi's intuition and persistence the project would never have materialised. I was also entirely happy with the professionalism with which Kimi ran the project, which was named as the most recommended programme of the night by many British newspapers.
